We manage the Eurasian Water Milfoil and other invasive species, monitor the water quality, work with the drain commissioner on the water level and drain, the DNR fisheries to ensure our lake is a healthy habitat for fish, and is well stocked. Boaters are kept informed of boater safety rules, and we do our best to protect the wildlife.

Social activities such as the Kids Fishing Tournament, Giant Beach Ball and Fourth of July Regatta help draw us together as a community. We communicate with and educate property owners and friends of the lake through our newsletters. Our website features a current calendar of events, and is a great source of information about Silver Lake in general. It is also a convenient way for members to contact board members regarding issues they are concerned about.
